## SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

### GENERAL INFORMATION

We're excited to host our first-ever Student Art Show May 12–14, 2022 at the Art School's Laguna Gloria campus. The exhibition will feature original creations by beginner and seasoned artists alike across a wide range of mediums. By showcasing the spectacular works of our talented students, the Student Art Show celebrates our beloved Art School community.

**The opening reception and celebration for the Student Art Show will take place on Wednesday, May 11 from 6–8P at Laguna Gloria.** The exhibition will be available to view during museum open hours:

Thursday, May 12 | 9A–9P

Friday, May 13 | 9A–3P

Saturday, May 14 | 9A–3P

### ELIGIBILITY

The Student Art Show is open to all Art School students ages 18+ who have participated in a class between January 1, 2021 – March 10, 2022. Students may submit up to 5 total works for consideration in any medium and at any scale, with the understanding that all submitted works must fit within a 3' x 6' exhibition space. ### HOW TO ENTER

***Submissions for the Student Art Show will be accepted starting 12P on Thursday, February 10, 2022 through 10P on Thursday, March 10, 2022.***

All entries must be completed using the online form at [thecontemporaryaustin.org/student-art-show](http://thecontemporaryaustin.org/student-art-show). Please read the submission guidelines carefully before beginning your application.

To begin the application process, you will be required to login to your Active user account. There is a \$30 application fee for each entry (which will be applied to production costs for the exhibition). Once you have completed your application, it is no longer accessible and cannot be edited. Be sure to click "Register" when you have finalized your application. After the open call period has ended, you will be notified by Art School staff members to confirm your participation in the Student Art Show and gather artwork submission details from you. If you would like to alter the number of work(s) or artwork medium(s) you selected during the application process, this is the time to make this adjustment.

## INSTALLATION

Students are fully responsible for the installation of their artwork for the Student Art Show. Each participant will be allotted a space measuring at least 3' x 6' to display their work. If your work requires more space, please specify in the registration questions and we will do our best to accommodate your needs. 2D artwork will not require framing. While framed artwork is welcome, we will provide binder clips and thumbtacks to neatly hang unframed work. If your work requires nails, a hammer, or additional supplies for installation, you will be responsible for supplying these materials and installing them yourself. Staff will be onsite to assist with setup needs, but not to do this for you.

## EVENT NIGHT

The Student Art Show will take place in The Contemporary Austin's Art School Studios, which will be converted into gallery spaces with designated areas for each participant. The opening celebration will include food, drink, and music. The Contemporary Austin continues to adhere to COVID safety recommendations from the City of Austin. Event capacity may be limited to decrease the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

## CLEAN UP

Each student is required to deinstall their artwork and restore and clean up their space by Monday, May 16. Students will gain access to the exhibition space for clean up between 9A-3P Sunday, May 15 and between 9A-4P on Monday, May 16. **All remaining work will be discarded after this time**, as we do not have the capacity to hold onto it.
